The overall objective of this project is to promote sustainable mobility along the Pan-European Corridor IV. The Ministry of Public Works, Transportation and Housing in Romania has as a strategic target the rehabilitation of the most trafficked railway lines transiting Romania on Trans-European Corridor IV. These lines are Bucharest-Constanta and Bucharest-Brasov.

The railway line Bucharest-Constanta has 225 km (the section 3 of 40 km and the section 4 of 38 km, both double tracked). Such rehabilitation will lead to increased travel speeds and reduced travel time for passengers and goods, increased transport safety and protection of the environment as well as to increased interoperability with EU standards.
